- *Exceptions:* Late registration will be permitted, but for organizational reasons, with an increased registration fee of €20, to be paid no later than Thursday 2 May 2024.

START AND FINISH PLACE: Canottieri Padova Asd

AWARDS: They will be given at the end of all scheduled races. A category will be established and medals will be awarded, with a minimum of three registered athletes.

“RENZO RAMPADO” TROPHY: At the end of all the scheduled races, the team ranking will be drawn up for all the clubs that field at least 5 athletes of any category in single boat (K1/C1). The sum of the times of only the 5 fastest athletes of each club will determine the team time.

The clubs with the three best team times will be rewarded with a cash prize worth:

1st place team €600.00
2nd place team €250.00 3rd place place team €150.00

ANTI-DOPING: Anti-doping controls may be carried out during the event by both NADO and the Italian Ministry of Health. Anti-Doping Investigation Inspectors (NAS personnel accredited by NADO - ITALY) may also be present, with the functions and prerogatives established by the art. 23 of the Anti-Doping Sports Regulations (Circular 08/2016)

NOTE:

- The race program and the starting modalities will be presented during the team leaders meeting;
- The weight control of the boats can be made after each arrival;
- The use of a life jacket is mandatory for categories U16;
- Boats must be rendered unsinkable;
- The use of suitable footwear for portages is recommended (not barefoot).
- The event will take place in the presence of any weather condition that does not affect the safety and health of the participants. If, due to force majeure or any other cause not attributable to the organization, the event does not take place, the participation fee will not be refunded.
